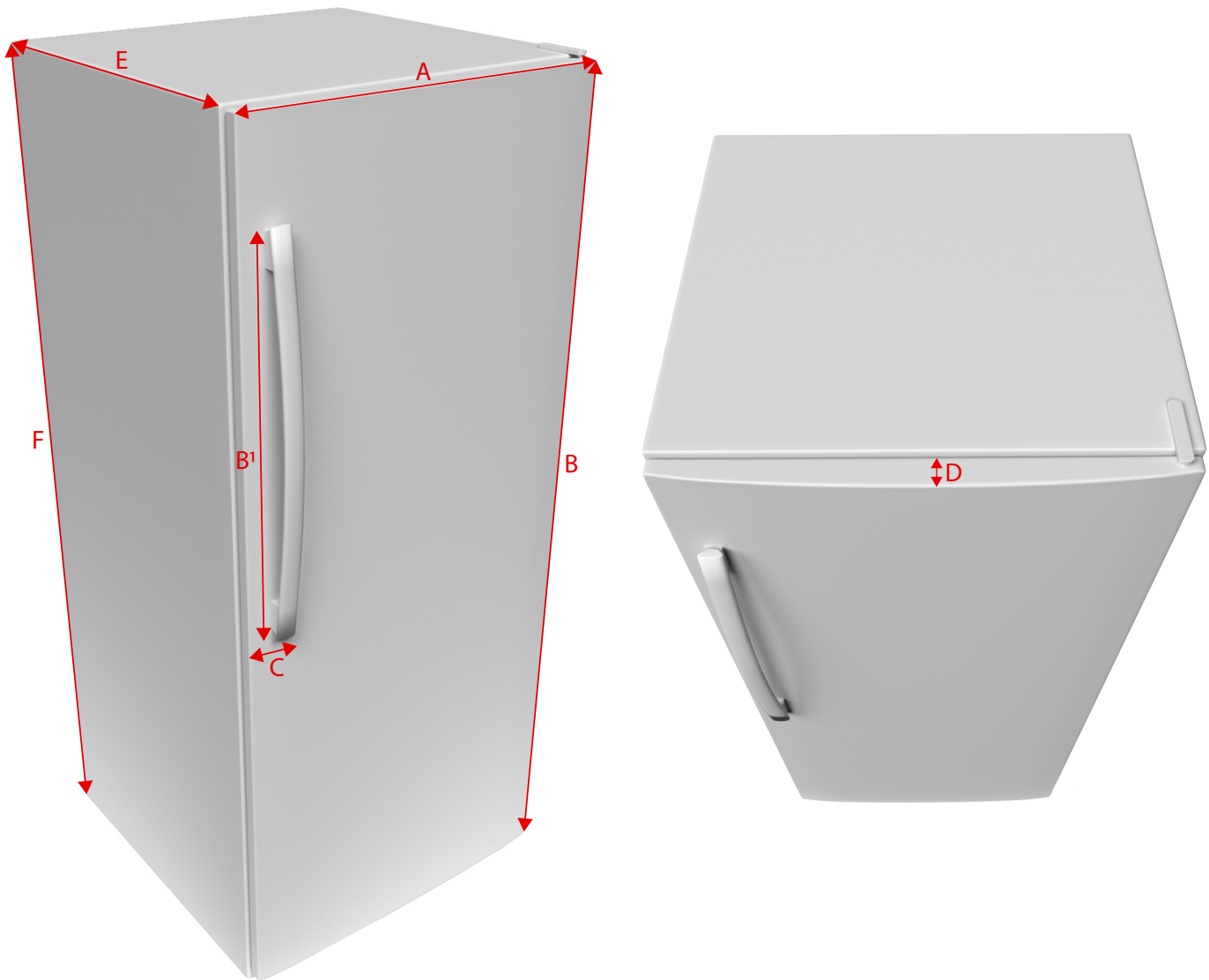


Measuring Your Upright Freezer/Refrigerator



Notes:

- For the Depth of your fridge (measurement **E**), measure the body of the refrigerator only - measure the depth of the doors (measurement **D**) separately. For Measurement **D** (door depth), measure at the thickest point (should be the middle of the door).

- For Measurement **C** (door handles), measure from the edge of the door inwards to the farthest edge of the door handle - this helps us account for door handles that aren't mounted flush to the edge of the door. For **B¹** measurement, measure the length of the door that the handle covers at the farthest points. Do not measure the handle along the raised (curved) area, as that will give a false (longer) measurement.

- Measurements **B** & **F** may not match, depending on the body and door style of your fridge, so it is important to take both.
